## TKC 2023 workshop on transport and economic prosperity – identifying research and data for achieving transport outcomes effectively and efficiently.

These will be captured on post-its and categorised at the workshop according to the <a href="Transport Outcomes Framework">Transport Outcomes Framework</a> and a measure of scale on multiple dimensions of impact/use/time.

You are welcome to bring your existing ideas for sharing on the day.

We will report back to all registered <u>Transport Knowledge Conference</u> attendees after the ideas are collated and organised.

Please note that these ideas are being collected based on open intellectual property to be further shared and developed by the <u>Transport Knowledge Hub</u> to identify research and data priorities.

## Some background.

This workshop responds to feedback from previous <u>Transport Knowledge Conferences</u> where attendees wanted to discuss research ideas more formally than through networking during the conference.

Waka Kotahi <u>Sector Research</u>, Te Manatū Waka's <u>Domestic Transport Costs and Charges</u> study and the Decarbonising Transport Research Strategy have delivered and identified research and data under the <u>Transport Evidence Base Strategy</u>. A summary of other significant data and research initiatives will also be shared during this workshop.
